Discussion with Katja Graumann (WG1 leader) about WG1 meeting organisation during the SEB conference in Florence

- We have announced during the kick-off meeting (Clermont-Ferrand, 12-14th March) the opportunity for COST-Action partners to participate to the SEB meeting in Florence (3-6 July 2018) and to organize a special session dedicated to WG1 & WG2. This first announcement was kindly recall by Katja Graumann to WG1 members (mail to WG1 participants, April 4th 2018). - Review of Milestones and Deliverables about the INDEPTH website. The web site is now open and can be reach at <https://www.brookes.ac.uk/indepth/> . WG5 has not yet advertised about the opening of the web site as some pages still need some editing.
- Discussion about the implementation of a searchable index in the INDEPTH website. The next step in our Website construction is to implement a searchable index. Aline Probst collected information from a google form (<https://goo.gl/forms/89Mb7m3RRX9MdQxI2>) so far from 53 institutions including name, institute, country, website, picture, keywords, short description of scientific activity and relevance to INDEPTH WG.

- These info will be used by Alun Wards to create a searchable index using main criteria of research such as keywords, species, plant organs or techniques. This will be of great help for PhD students to look for lab to learn relevant techniques through STSM.
